RE: **COVID Update – Visitation Guidelines**

Effective immediately – the guidelines for visitations for Residents have changed as per the California Department of Social Services. The major changes are as follows:

Indoor visitations – (including joining your loved one in the Dining Room and spending time in common areas):

- A. visitors must show proof of vaccination status *OR*
- B. proof of a negative COVID test within 2 days for PCR and within 1 day for antigen test (home tests).
- C. Masks are required for visitors at all times
- D. Reservations for meals are required

If someone is visiting on multiple consecutive days and have shown proof of vaccination (A) then they do not need to provide any test results.

If someone is visiting on multiple consecutive days and have not shown proof of vaccination (B) then they need to present proof of a negative test on every third day during the visit (i.e. day 1,4,7).

Outdoor visitations –

- A. Masks are still required at all times

If you are visiting with someone who cannot leave (different then do not want to) their apartment and enjoy an outdoor visit with you – you can enter and visit in the apartment even if you do not have proof of vaccination or cannot provide a negative test result. The visit **MUST** take place only in the apartment. If the Resident has a roommate than you are **NOT** allowed to visit indoors as that would place the roommate at risk.

**IMPORTANT: Staff and Visitors are REQUIRED to wear a mask at all times in the facility as per the Department of Social Services Guidelines.
Please do not challenge this requirement.**
